301. Korbel Brut, California

Blend of multiple varieties from multiple appellations and even multiple years. Each grape variety and appellation used contributes a unique character to the final blend.

302. Iron Horse Wedding Cuvee, Russian River Valley, California

59

Fruit forward, dry and elegant, with gorgeous tiny bubbles and a remarkably long finish. By nose: Raspberry, Mandarin Orange, and Nutmeg. In the mouth: Stone Fruit, Pink Grapefruit, Tahitian Lime, Blood Orange, Raspberry with a gentle mouth-feel.

303. Asti Spumante, Martini and Rossi, Piedmont, Italy

34

Multi-award winning, produced only in the Piedmont region of North-West Italy. After being picked from its hillside vineyards, the Moscato grape is quickly pressed and fermented only once to a light degree of alcohol thereby retaining its natural sweetness with notes of Grape, Melon, and Peach.

304. Prosecco, Caposaldo, Vento, Italy

35

Bright with persistent bubbles, the wine has a fruity aroma of Citrus, Green Apple and Acacia Blossoms. On the palate, the elegant, brut-style wine has a pleasant acidity and freshness and a soft, round mouth feel.

305. Wycliff, California

311. Dom Perignon, Moet Chandon, France

On the nose, aromas of Almond and Powdered Cocoa develop gradually into White fruit with hints of dried flowers. On the palate, the wine instantly traces an astoundingly fine line between density and weightlessness. Its precision is extreme, tactile, dark and chiseled.

Ripe, supple, and of medium body, this classic expression of Pouilly-Fuissé shows vibrant fruit flavors with notes of Melon and Minerals, gently touched with Oak, ending in a fresh, silky finish.

Riesling

12. Mercer Estates, Yakima Valley, California (Medium Drv)

29

Succulent Ripe Peach, Lychee and Honeysuckle greet you on the nose. The voluminous fruit is balanced with notes of Lemon Custard and minerality. The ripe, lush fruit is framed by bright, fresh acidity creating a wine that is refreshing and naturally balanced.

13. Gustava Larentz Reserve, Alsace, France (Dry)

21. Pighin, Aziende Agricole, Friuli, Italy

22. Santa Margherita, Valdadige DOC, Italy

Clean, intense aroma and bone-dry taste (with an appealing flavor of Golden Delicious Apples) make this Pinot Grigio a wine of great personality and versatility.

23. Maryhill, Milbrandt Vineyards, Columbia Valley, Washington

28

Aromas of sweet Orange Blossom and Pink Grapefruit with a hint of Pear on the nose. Ready the palate for sun kissed Orange and summertime Lemonade.

Sauvignon Blanc

26. Nobilo, Marlborough, New Zealand

Herbaceous notes of freshly cut Grass along with Honeydew Melon, Jasmine, Hints of Mandarin, and a slight Minerality. Fresh and crisp with zesty flavors of Ripe Tropical Fruits follow through to display a pleasant roundness with great depth. This wine unfolds to show Fruit-Salad notes and Canned Peaches and Pears.

27. Materra, Napa Valley, California

Distinct aromas of Pineapple, Lemon zest, Citrus rind, and river rock flood the senses. On the palate, a bright tartness hits your tongue with lingering flavors of Apricot and White Peach ending with a light effervesces.

28. Tabali, Limari Valley, Chile

In the nose is shows a great character, complexity, elegance and a very intense and unique minerality with some Citric notes, White Flowers and a touch of Green Aromas. In the palate has a gorgeous volume, mineral, crispy with a great acidity and a salty aftertaste due to the limestone soil. Very long, fresh and elegant finish.

29. Chalone Vineyard, Monterey, California

34

Pleasing aromas of Lemongrass and tropical fruits fill the nose; on the palate, flavors of Citrus and Melon make this a delightful wine.

Other Whites

35. Vouvray, Domaine de Vaufuget, Loire Valley, France

32

The wine gives a sweet sensation with a dry finish on the palate. A concentration of rich flavors develops fruity aromas such as Fresh Grapes and Ripe Quinces with slight Honey notes.

36. Conundrum, Rutherford, California

38

From the premier winegrowing regions, this wine is both exotic and bright, a blend of Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon, Muscat Canelli and Viognier. It lures you in with scents of Apricot, Pear and Honeysuckle, and if you're paying attention, Orange and Lemon Meringue Pie. Initial sweetness is balanced by natural acidity, and we love the hint of Oak that plays with flavors of Peach, Apple and Citrus.

37. Viognier, Materra, Napa, California

This Vigonier blossoms with the floral fragrance of Honeysuckle, Spice, Citrus and a hint of Lemon zest. 51. Burgess, Merryvale Family Vineyards, Napa Valley, California

Created from 100% Merlot grapes, this wine displays flavors of Cocoa, Cranberry, Orange Zest, Cherry and Pipe Tobacco. The palate shows a velvety texture and good length, round and balanced without being oppressively heavy.

52. Starmont, Merryvale Family Vineyards, Napa Valley, California

49

Aromas of Blackberry, Bramble, Blueberry, light Baking Spices, freshly grated Ginger, Violets and Sarsaparilla. On the palate, the entry is soft and velvety with good balance and refined tannins that are wrapped around a nice acidic structure. Flavors of Dark Berry and Violets finish with a hint of Dark Chocolate.

53. Chalone, Monterey, California

34

This wine had a gorgeous, classic, elegant nose from the get-go. Laced with Oak, it has beautiful Cherry aromas and subtle Baking Spices. With subtle hints of Clove and Allspice, it is smooth, velvety, round, and well balanced.

54. Blackbird, Casa Tiene Vista Vineyard, Fallbrook, California

58

Blackbird is a full bodied wine, rich in flavors of Berry, Plum and Currant. Great upfront nose with a Peppery finish. This wine tends to have a Black-Blue hue, with legs that go on forever. The name Merlot is thought to be derived from the old French word for young Blackbird. Merlot, a diminutive of Merle, the Blackbird (Turdus Merula), is reminiscent of the color of the Grape. Aged in Oak this rich bodied wine is perfect with meats.

55. Round Hill, California

34

A Ruby Colored Wine, bright and flavorful with Ripe Berry fruit and Spice notes. Aromas and flavors of Ripe Strawberry, Cranberry, Vanilla and Dark Chocolate. Soft, elegant mouthfeel with refined, silky Tannins and smooth finish.

Pinot Noir

63. Aguinas, Napa & Sonoma Counties, California

An intensely aromatic wine displaying notes of Sweet Cherry, Tahitian Vanilla Crème Brulee and Raspberry Compote. It has a remarkably rich fruit flavor of sweet Cranberry and Pomegranate, both nuances of Napa, along with Sour Cherry and a pleasant Earthiness, contributions from the Sonoma Coast.

62. Meiomi, Sonoma County, California

40

The wine opens to reveal lifted fruit aromas of bright Strawberry and Jammy Fruit, Mocha, and Vanilla, along with Toasty Oak notes. Expressive Boysenberry, Blackberry, Dark Cherry, Juicy Strawberry, and Toasty Mocha flavors lend complexity and depth on the palate. The well-integrated Oak provides structure and depth seldom seen in Pinot Noir.

64. A by Acacia, California

66. City Lights, Casa Tiene Vista, California

Grown in the rolling hills of DeLuz, where the cool morning ocean breezes combined with sunny days makes for ideal growing conditions for this Grape. The results -are a medium bodied wine with aromas of Black Cherry, Raspberry and Current.

67. Balletto, Pinot Noir, Russian River Valley, California

48

Forest-floor Earthliness, Dark, Savory Spice and a slight touch of Bright Red Fruit combine with a silky palate that lingers over its poised, age-worthy structure. There's the crisp acidity that keeps the wine lively and intertwines gracefully with the structure. So serious, yet balanced and approachable.

67. Willamette Valley Vineyards, Willamette Valley, California

70. Decoy by Duckhorn, Sonoma, California

Rich and appealing with fragrant. Lifted aromas of Mulberry, Raspberry and Currant with hints of Rhubarb and Mocha. Soft toned fruit flavors with engaging Spice complexity

71. Materra, Napa Valley, California

72

On the nose Black Cherries, Currants, Blackberries, Plums and Raspberries. Other flavors follow with hints of Coffee, Chocolate, Cocoa, White Pepper and Vanilla. On the palate the wine is crisp, with mouth-watering acidity. The soft tannins add a very soft velvet texture. Dark fruits are abundant, Cherries, Figs, and Cedar Box.

72. Liberty School, Hope Family Wines, Paso Robles, California

38

Ruby black in color, Liberty School Cabernet Sauvignon displays classic Cabernet aromas of Black Currant, Crushed Blackberry and Cherry, with undertones of Charred Sandalwood, Black Peppercorn, Eucalyptus and a dash of Cinnamon. 74. Peirano Estate, Hertiage Collection, Lodi, California

29

The rich, dark color of this wine catches you from the first pour. It exhibits a rich deep burgundy hue with perfect clarity. The aromas are a compendium of Zesty Black Cherries, Cola, and Toasty Cocoa. The first initial sip fills the mouth with sweet Anise, Black Boysenberry, Cherry, Molasses, and Baked Blackberry Pie, while maintaining absolute dryness and firm, round, yet supple, Tannins.

75. Silver Oaks, Alexander Valley, California

98

Harmonious and vibrant wine. This full-bodied, classic expression of Alexander Valley Cabernet in a cool vintage has a bright Ruby-Red color with Purple undertones. The nose exudes aromas of Black Cherry, Cedar and Black Olives. On the palate, its Dried Herb, Cocoa and Lavender flavors are framed by Dusty Tannins and a savory texture. This wine finishes with lively acidity and a lingering persistence.

76. City Lights, Casa Tiene Vista, California

36

This rich-bodied Cabernet has a deep color with aromas of Vanilla, Oak, Light Leather, and a Buttery taste, combined this with a crisp smooth finish. It has a round mouth feel and a long after taste.

77. Ironstone Vineyards, Lodi, California

35

Rich and complex, but still easily approachable. Its Dark Cherry and Toasted Oak aromas tantalize the taste buds that will savor juicy Black Currant, Raspberry and Dark Cherry flavors. This luscious, well-balanced, wine has a sweet middle palate that finishes with a lovely Toasty Oak component.

Other Reds

80. Essential Red, Blend, Bogle Vineyards, California

Compelling blend of California's finest plantings of Old Vine Zinfandel, Syrah, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Petite Sirah, this wine surpasses all expectation for pure enjoyment and approachability. Enticing layers of complexity, starting with that first irresistible sip. Ripe fruit, intense with flavors of Boysenberries and Sweet Cherries, Luscious Vanilla, caressing the palate from Barrel aging in American and French Oak. Juicy and silky throughout, with a finish that lingers of Black Licorice and Spicy Pipe Tobacco.

81. Chianti, Fattoria di Lucignano, Tuscany, Italy

33

Medium intensity. Ruby Red Fruit with an intense nose of Black Cherry and Violet. Soft, medium-bodied, moderate acidity, quite Tannic.

82. Petite Sirah, The Crusher, California

30

Brimming with aromatics; Wisteria Blossom, Cherries and Crème Brûlée perforate the senses. Dense flavors of Milk Chocolate, Blueberry and Clove mingle harmoniously to create this deep, rich and expressive wine. Spending nearly fourteen months in 90% French Oak, the presence of a Vanilla core is undeniable. Together these dark fruit flavors, spice notes and floral aromatics create a wonderfully refined glass of wine with a polished finish.

83. Côtes du Rhône, Réserve, Famille Perrin, France

30

The Côtes du Rhône Reserve is a good wine in the vintage and offers lots of Pepper, Bouquet Garni, Licorice and Mineral characteristics in a medium-bodied, tight, fresh profile.

84. Old Vine Zinfandel, Project Paso, Paso Robles, California

34
